

Four CHiP's

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Nauman

START POSITION: All shooters standing with hands on head in the Holding Area. Handgun is loaded and holstered in the ready condition per rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.

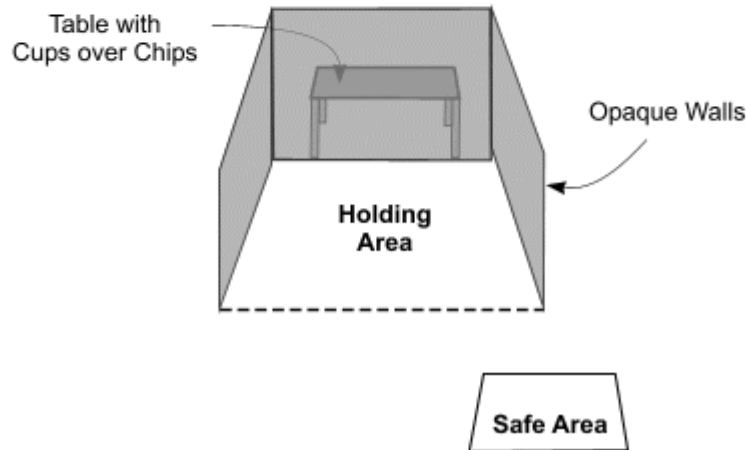
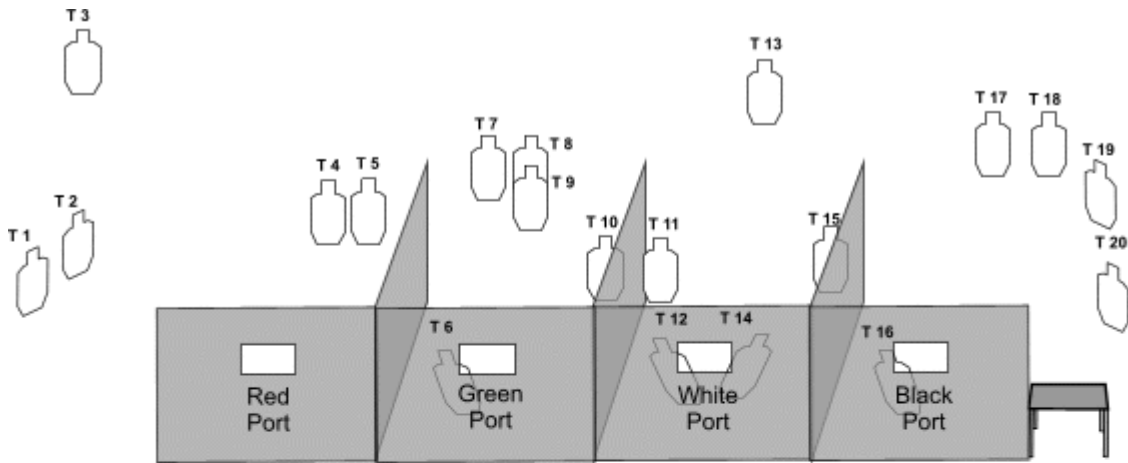
STAGE PROCEDURE

Each shooter in turn leaves the Holding Area retrieves and retains a colored poker chip from under any cup on uprange table. The shooter then turns, draws and engages the targets visible through the port of the same color as the chip. When the shooter is finished the handgun is placed safely on the downrange table.

After entering the Safe Area, the shooter shouts "Go!" which is the signal for the next shooter to begin.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 40 rounds, 200 points
TARGETS: 20 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot of final shooter
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use solid, opaque walls to block view of Ports and Table from the Holding Area.
