

Nevada Section Slot Policy

Approved May, 31 2007

Article 1: Purpose

1.1 It is the policy of the Nevada Section to reward members of the section for their dedication to USPSA shooting in the section by awarding slots to the various yearly National Championship matches based on a member's activity in the section during the shooting year.

Article 2: Definitions

2.1 The shooting year is recognized as January 1st through December 31st each calendar year.

2.2 A section member is any shooter who is a member in good standing with any Nevada Section club and the United States Practical Shooting Association.

2.3 A Nevada Section Club is any club listed by the USPSA as being part of the Nevada Section.

2.4 A qualifying event is activity the section member participates in that results in the member being awarded an activity point.

Article 3: Activity Point Awards

3.1 Section members who desire a slot to a Nationals match will be awarded one section slot point for the following activity.

3.1.1 Competing in any recognized Nevada Section monthly club match.

3.1.2 Competing in any recognized Nevada State and/or Section Championship match.

3.1.3 Competing in any recognized Area 1 Championship match.

3.1.4 Participating in a recognized range maintenance/cleanup activity.

3.2 Section members who desire a slot to a Nationals match will also be awarded one section slot point for the following activity.

3.2.1 Working as a part of the match staff or planning committee for any recognized Nevada State and /or Section Championship match.

3.2.2 Working as a part of the match staff or planning committee for any recognized Area 1 Championship match.

3.2.3 Working as a part of the match staff or planning committee for any Nationals match held within the Nevada Section.

Article 4: Data Collection

4.1 Section members who desire a section slot to a Nationals Championship match must notify the Section Coordinator in writing of their desire during the month of January of the year immediately following the shooting year.

4.2 The Section Coordinator will submit to each Club President within the first seven days of February, the names of the section members who are on the slots list.

4.3 The Club Presidents will provide the Section Coordinator with the number of activity points awarded to each section member on the list by their perspective club during the shooting year no later than February 28th.

4.4 It is the soul responsibility of the section member to insure the correct data for their activity points is submitted to the Section Coordinator in a timely manor.

Article 5: Slot Awards

5.1 The Section Coordinator will notify the Club Presidents as soon as the slots are received from the USPSA and indicate the number of sots received for the National Championship matches for that year.

5.2 The Section Coordinator will conduct an award lottery no later than two weeks after receiving the slots and distribute the slots immediately after the selection.

5.3 The lottery will be conducted in the presence of the Section Coordinator, at least one club president, and at least one impartial observer.

5.4 Each section member desiring a Nationals slot will have their name entered into the lottery once for each activity point they receive for the shooting year.

5.5 One name will be drawn from the lottery for each slot. Once a section member's name has been drawn and a slot awarded their name will be removed from the lottery. No section member may receive more than one slot to a National's Championship match in the same shooting year.

5.6 It is the sole responsibility of the section member who is awarded a slot to a National's Championship match to complete the application packet and return it to the USPSA offices before the filing deadline. Should a section member fail to file their application in a timely manner and thus lose the slot, they will be barred from receiving a section slot for the next two shooting years.
